Paint Set Option 1

This option is for you if you are more interested in just trying out watercolor. It is a less expensive option. This is a pan watercolor set, but don't be fooled pan watercolors come in several different grade levels including craft grade, student grade and professional grade. This is a high quality student grade set.

Do not bring prang or crayola paint sets these are opaque watercolor food dyes and will not work very well.

2 full sheets - 140 lb. or 300 lb. cold pressed full sheets 22" x 30"(approximately)

Towels or Rags

1- roll paper towels

Brushes

Watercolor brushes a soft hair brushes. Look for sable or synthetic/sable blends or high quality sythetic brushes. Watercolor brushes can be expensive so I have suggested a good quality student grade. These can do most things your more expensive brushes can do but are significantly less expensive than pure sable brushes.

Flats

1- 3" or 4" goat hair brush(This type of brush shouldn't cost more than 5\$)

Soft hair Watercolor brushes

*Note*Cotman makes affordable quality brushes
These are synthetic and sable blended brushes*

1- 1" brush

1- 1/2" brush

Rounds

1- #3 round

1- #5 round

1- #8 round

Thinners

Water

Thinner Container Cleaner

1 – roll (not needed if you get 300 lb paper)

9" x 12" sketch book(multi-media if possible)
