

Watercolor Painting Supplies List

Paint Set Option 1

Winsor Newton Cotman Pan set 14 color or 24 color set (full pan sets are easier to work with.)

Tube Colors Option 2

Watercolor Paint Brands Winsor Newton

Colors or Grumbacher. The smallest tubes will work

Winsor Lemon or Hansa Yellow Light

Winsor Orange or Hansa Orange

Winsor Red or Naphol Red

Alizarin Crimson

Winsor Violet or Dixiozine Purple

Winsor French Ultramarine Or Ultramarine Blue

Winsor Green Blue Shade or Thalo Green

Paynes Gray

Burnt Umber

Mixing Palette

Watercolor enameled tray or plastic palette(white 10" x 10" porcelain tiles work great for this)

Drawing Board

At least a 16" x 20" or similar sized board 1/4" wood hardboard

*****(NOT FOAM BOARD NOR GATOR BOARD)*****

Watercolor Paper

Brands: D'Arches or Arches and or Winsor, and Newton

2 full sheets-140lb. cold pressed

or

300lb. cold pressedfull sheets 22"x 30"(approximately)

note 140lb will need to be stretched. You will need at least a 1/4" wood hardboard 16" x 20" approximately (not foam board or gator board)

Towels or Rags

1-roll paper towels

Water Spray Bottle

1-regular spray bottle

Sponges

1-cellulose sponges(just plain rectangular kitchen sponges)

Brushes

Watercolor brushes soft hair brushes. Look for sable or synthetic/sable blends or high-quality synthetic brushes. Watercolor brushes can be expensive so I have suggested a good quality student grade. These can do most things your more expensive brushes can do, but are significantly less expensive than pure sable brushes.

Note* Cotman makes affordable quality brushes. These are synthetic and sable blended brushes. If you use the cheaper synthetics they will be harder to use.
